Media influences are very much a part of the life of young people. It is extremely important for parents to monitor the movies watched, the books read, and especially computer use of their teens. Computers and other media devices should have safe guards on them and be accessible to parents for the safety of their youth.

The basic point is that parents need to be involved with their children. The more you know about the daily events of your children's lives, the better you are able to spot danger signs that may surface. The more regular your communication with your children, the freer they will be to come to you with their concerns.
